I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth. ² My soul shall make her boast in the LORD: the humble shall hear thereof, and be glad. ³ O magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together. ⁴I sought the LORD, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears. 5 They looked unto him, and were lightened: and their faces were not ashamed. 6 This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him, and saved him out of all his troubles. ⁷ The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them. 8 O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him. ⁹O fear the LORD, ye his saints: for there is no want to them that fear him. 10 The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing. 11 Come, ye children, hearken unto me: I will teach you the fear of the LORD. 12 What man is he that desireth life, and loveth many days, that he may see good? 13 Keep thy tongue from evil, and thy lips from speaking guile. 14 Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it. 15 The eyes of the LORD are upon the righteous, and his ears are open unto their cry. 16 The face of the LORD is against them that do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth. ¹⁷ The righteous cry, and the LORD heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles. ¹⁸ The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit. 19 Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them all. ²⁰He keepeth all his bones: not one of them is broken. ²¹ Evil shall slav the wicked: and they that hate the righteous shall be desolate. ²² The LORD redeemeth the soul of his servants: and none of them that trust in him shall be desolate. You will find comfort and peace in reading this Psalm. Thank you Lord for all You have done for us.

Responsive Reading Good to Give Thanks Psalm 92

Minister: It is good thing to give thanks unto the Lord, and to sing praises unto thy name, o most High:

Congregation: To show forth thy lovingkindness in the morning, and thy faithfulness every night.

Minister: Upon an instrument of ten strings, and upon psalerty; upon the harp with a solemn sound.

Congregation: For thou, Lord hast made me glad through thy work: I will triumph in the works of thy hands.

Minister: O Lord, how great are thy works! And thy thoughts are very deep.

Congregation: A bruitish man knoweth not; neither doth a fool understand this.

Minister: When the wicked spring as the grass, and when all the workers of iniquity do flourish; it is that they shall be destroyed for ever:

Congregation: But thou, Lord, art most high for evermore.

Minister: For, Io, thine enemies, O Lord, for, Io, thine enemies, shall perish;

Congregation: All the workers of iniquity shall be scattered.
